# Help protect Mob from HPV

## What you can do:

- Talk to your young ones about the importance of the HPV vaccine.
- Make sure your young ones get their HPV vaccine at school.
- If they missed out on the vaccine at school, make sure they get a catch-up dose.


**All young ones of any gender can get the HPV vaccine for free at school when they are 12-13 years old.**

**If you've missed out you can catch up for free until you turn 26 through your local Aboriginal Health Service, local council, doctor or at some pharmacies. Contact them to find out more and book an appointment.**
